

Monday June 12th – Natchez Trace Parkway Drive

We'll gather in the Hampton parking lot at 8:30am to head out at 9:00 for the Natchez Trace Parkway. This is a beautiful drive down a 2-lane historic road. The Trace had been an important foot trail back in the late 1700s before it evolved into one of America's first National Roads in the early 1800s. It linked Nashville with Natchez, a town of strategic importance that was founded by the French in 1716. Both cities were major hubs of commerce at the time.

After we jump off the Natchez Trace, we'll head across to Lawrenceburg for lunch at Hinie's BBQ (price and preset menu coming soon) and stop in at Butler Performance Pontiac https://butlerperformance.com/ for a 30 minute tour by the owner Dave Butler. We'll have a schedule for the tours closer to time. Butler is known to many Trans Am owners as a place to get everything to make our Pontiac engine perform it's best and increase your horsepower.





But if it's a different kind of horsepower you're interested in, just follow the horse and buggies up the road from our stop in Lawrenceburg to Ethridge. Ethridge is in the heart of Amish country and just up the road is the Amish Heritage Welcome Center And Museum, the Amish Country Mall and several other Amish businesses.





Although normally closed on Tuesdays, Lane is opening up just for us!! 
You'll have about 4 ½ hours before you'll need to head back to Gallatin for our evening's events.





POINTS TO REMEMBER FOR A SUCCESSFUL BANDIT RUN EXPERIENCE:

- 1. Please have cash ready for our tours, museums, and lunches. It makes everything go faster and smoother and not all places are equipped to handle credit cards. I've tried to list and put in bold within the itinerary all of the current fees we have negotiated so you can plan ahead. Most of the time you will be handing cash directly to the museum/restaurant, however some of those times Bandit Run staff may be collecting the money.
- 2. Our routes may change before or even the day of a drive. We work to make sure we have the safest and best routes and monitor road closures and construction areas. Planning months in advance we can't know all possible issues that may come up. But never worry, we'll all get there together.
- 3. We are a large group this year, please use a CB if possible to keep in communication with other Runners and the lead cars. We do our very best to pace the group so no one gets left behind and give out directions, turns and addresses via the CB as we are driving. However, if you don't hear it, your itinerary has a map and turn-by-turn directions on where we are going.
- 4. If you have car trouble, pull over to the side of the road and let other Runners know you need help. Most likely, before you even say it, others will have followed you off the road already ready to pitch in and help.
- 5. It's not a race. It's a leisurely drive down backroads. We try to stay off the interstates as much as we can (we can drive those anytime). But if you feel you must get there sooner or prefer to take the interstate to our routes, you are welcome to break off and go on without the group. You will have the addresses and information of our destinations to use to assist you,
- 6. Sometimes our routes may not make sense to you. Keep in mind what routes work for 5 cars, 25 cars or even 75 cars, won't work for 135 cars. We work to keep our impact on the local area to a minimum and that often means taking what seems to be a round-about route. We try to avoid city centers and areas with excessive stoplights where there's a chance the group gets broken up too much.
- 7. Above all else, have fun. Meet new people, make new friends. You can show off, but don't break any laws. We don't bring bail money.
